The Low Income Heating Grant was started to avoid financial hardship in the Rotorua community, where, as part of improving air quality, older wood burners (pre Sept 2005) will be required to be upgraded in the near future. The purpose is to provide assistance to home owners who have limited means to upgrade their heating and where this situation is unlikely to change. Accepting homeowners into the Grants Scheme is at the full discretion of Bay of Plenty Regional Council.
